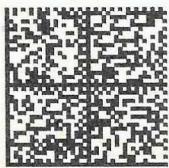

1. Qualifying Marks for General Candidates : For all subjects 35% each except 2nd language (20%).
2. PH-III Candidates are awarded Grades and Grade Points on par with General Candidates whereas PH-I & II and PH-IV Candidates are awarded Grades and Grade Points in their own group.
3. PH-I Candidates are allowed to opt any one language out of 3 languages and their qualifying marks is 20% in each subject.
4. PH-II Candidates to appear for all subjects and their qualifying marks is 20% in each subject.
5. PH-IV candidates are exempted from appearing for 3rd language (English) only but their qualifying marks for each subject is 35% except 2nd language (20%).
6. OSSC Candidates are awarded Grades and Grade Points in their own group.
7. Grade Point Average (GPA) is average of subject wise Grade Points.
